

# 2012 \* COBB MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST \* 2013

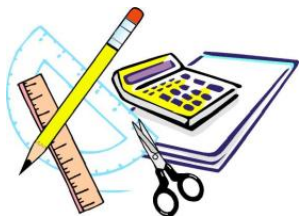

Students who wish to have access to a hall lock and locker will be charged a **\$5.00** rental fee.

*In an effort to keep cost down for our parents this is a generic supply list. If there is a specific item that a student will need in addition to what is on the list it will be noted during the first week of classes in the individual teacher's syllabus.*

It is **NOT** necessary to bring all of your supplies on the first day of school. In fact, lockers are not usually issued until at least Friday of the first week. During the first week of classes have your child bring **ONLY** the basics (i.e. what he/she will not mind carrying around with them all day) until instructed otherwise by specific teachers.



**ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:** Some elective classes (such as art or chorus) have additional supply requirements

- ✓ **6<sup>th</sup> Grade Magnet Program Supplies:** set of dividers with 5 tabs, three-subject lab book, glue sticks, and non anti-bacterial hand soap.
- ✓ **Algebra and Geometry:** Scientific Calculator TI-30 / TI-34 or higher
- ✓ **Magnet Science (6<sup>th</sup> grade), Biology Honors, Physical Science Honors, Earth/Space Science Honors:** Non-latex gloves [box of 50 (25 pair)]

**SUGGESTED HOME MATERIALS:** paper, poster board, metric ruler, pencils, pens, glue, dictionary, scissors, colored pencils, markers, calculator

**BACKPACKS:** Backpacks are not allowed to be taken into the classrooms. For the schools purpose, a backpack is defined as any bag containing two straps designed to be carried over one or both shoulders. All backpacks must fit in the lockers. The inside dimensions of lockers are 11 ¾ inches by 10 ¾ inches. If your backpack is larger than these dimensions, it will not fit in your locker and may **NOT** be brought to school! Shop carefully.

### **PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

Each student enrolled in P.E. will be assigned their own P.E. locker at the beginning of the year. All students must provide a combination lock (ONLY) for use of P.E. lockers. Students are not to share locks or lockers with their classmates. Students will be required to dress out each day. The P.E. uniform consists of solid BLACK shorts and a PURPLE or GRAY t-shirt. P.E. uniforms may be purchased through the P.E. Department at the beginning of each semester and throughout the year.

### **SCHOOL HOURS AND SUPERVISION REMINDERS**

Students enter the building at 9:24 A.M. and exit at 3:50 P.M. unless under the supervision of a teacher or staff member. All parents/visitors must sign in at the front office. We need ALL parents to assist us with our after school Safety Plan. We are concerned that too many students are unsupervised in the afternoons. Please note the current rules that are in place for reasons for child safety:

- General supervision is from 8:45 A.M. to 4:20 P.M.
- All students must go to an authorized area, bus stop, parent pick up or a supervised after school activity by 4:00 P.M.
- Supervision is provided at the bus loop until the last bus leaves. (Approximately 4:00 P.M.)
- Supervision is provided at parent pick up until 4:20 P.M. (see posted signs)
- No school child is authorized to be in an unsupervised area after 4:20 P.M.
- ALL after school activity students must be picked up by 5:00 P.M. as a conditioned of continued participation, unless other arrangements are made with the activity sponsor.
- Students participating in sports/practice **MUST** be picked up within 15 minutes of designated ending time of practice.

***Parents, please work with us to make sure that all of our students are always supervised and safe.***
