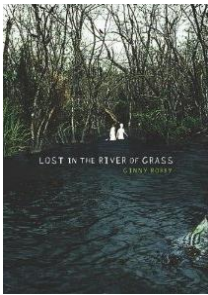


Cobb Middle School 2013 Magnet Summer Reading

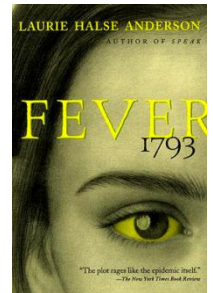
Lost in the River of Grass by Ginny Rorby
