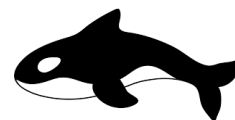

6th Grade Magnet SeaWorld Overnight Field Trip



Dear Parents:

We are so excited to invite your child to attend Cobb's sixth grade Magnet overnight field trip to SeaWorld Orlando! The SeaWorld sleepover is unlike any other field trip, and these memories will last a lifetime.

Buses will depart Cobb Middle School on Thursday, May 19th, 2016 at 7:30am and return on Friday, May 20th, 2016 at 11:00pm. **The total cost for this adventure is \$205.00** and includes SeaWorld admission and accommodations (\$97.92: late night pizza snack and dessert on Thursday, breakfast on Friday, sleepover accommodations, park admission, and guided, behind the scenes tours), chartered bus transportation (\$79.58), a Cobb Magnet 6th Grade Field Trip t-shirt (\$8.00), a Cobb Magnet sling bag (\$7.00), snacks (\$7.50), and admission to Santa Fe Zoo College (\$5.00). Additional money for lunch on Thursday, lunch and dinner on Friday, any other snacks, and souvenirs will be needed.

Due to limited space, we can only accept the first 100 students who make their non-refundable deposit of \$105.00 by Friday, December 4th, 2015. The remaining balance of \$100.00 must be paid by Friday, March 4th, 2016. Money will be collected by Mrs. Curry in Room 2. In April, students will receive a packet that must be completed in order to attend the trip. This includes paperwork that is required by Leon County Schools AND SeaWorld Orlando.

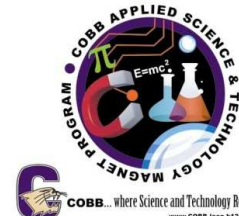
