6 <sup>th</sup> Grade

7 <sup>th</sup> Grade
*Earth Space Science Honors (high school credit) or Advanced Integrated Science *Algebra I Honors **Latin I, **French I or **Spanish I (high school credit)
8 <sup>th</sup> Grade
*Physical Science Honors, Biology Honors (high school credit) or Advanced Integrated Science *Geometry Honors (high school credit) or *Algebra I Honors (high school credit) or Talented Math or Advanced Math **Latin II, **French II or **Spanish II (high school credit)

\*Admission into a high school level class will be made by teacher recommendation, previous year's grades with a minimum 3.0 grade point average (GPA) and a semester average of 3.0 in all core classes, and acceptable performance on course entrance exam (administered in the spring). A student can choose, even if recommended, to not take a high school credit class.

\*\*Student placement in a foreign language class will be based upon a minimum of 3.0 GPA and a 3.0 semester average in a student's language arts class.
