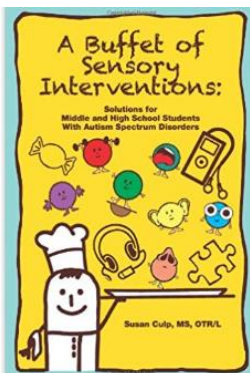




Good Eats: A Buffet of Sensory Interventions
