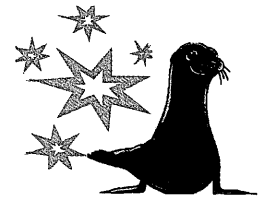

I have ALREADY made contact with individuals who may be considered a “close contact”. A close contact is defined as someone who was within six feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes.

Sealey will continue to work closely with the Leon County Health Department when we are informed of a new positive case and/or exposure.
