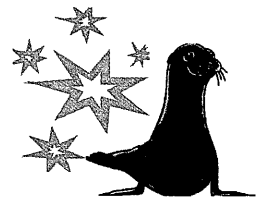

Dear Sealey Family,

Today we received notice that one of our staff members has tested positive for COVID-19. Please join me in wishing this Sealey family member well.

Over the next 24 hours, the Leon County Department of Health will contact **anyone who potentially had close contact with the staff** and advise them of the next steps they must follow. A close contact is defined as someone who was within six feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes.

The Leon County Health Department is in the process of contact tracing and will directly notify families or personnel if they have been potentially exposed. These exposures, unfortunate as they are, **highlight the importance of everyone doing their part** to minimize the spread of this virus: **stay home when sick or while waiting for Covid-19 test results**, keep things clean and sanitized, utilize proper hand washing, wear masks, and maintain physical distancing.
