# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

<u>Late arrivals</u> - School begins at 8:30. Students who arrive after that time must be escorted by a parent to the front office. The student will be marked tardy. DO NOT DROP YOUR STUDENT OFF.

<u>Leaving early</u> - if your child needs to leave early for an appointment, **they must be picked up by 2:15**.

Students will not be dismissed early after that time. <u>Car pick up</u> - If you have a student who rides a car, be sure to have your tag EVERY DAY so that dismissal runs smoothly and safely! Additionally, coverage is provided until 3:20. Any student left after that time may be taken to our after-school program where a fee will be imposed.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION 2021-2022

Kindergarten\*\* (and new student) enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year begins April 1, 2021! Please go to the following address to complete the required online registration.

After you have filled out the online registration, the following documents must be supplied to the registrar to complete enrollment (these can be brought in person to ATMSA's office, or emailed directly to the registrar, Janice Sellars at sellarsj@leonschools.net.

- \_**\***Copy of certified birth certificate
- \_\*Current health physical, signed by healthcare provided, dated between August 2020-August 2021
- \*Immunization record up to date, signed and certified by healthcare provider
- \*Two proofs of address, one from each category below according to LCS policy:
  - **A.** A current utility bill dated within 30 days/activation notice OR mortgage/HUD statement OR deed with signatures OR lease agreement OR current Homestead Exemption card
  - **B**. Home/renter's insurance bill OR medical insurance statement OR property tax record OR termite bond OR vehicle registration OR for renters—a current utility bill dated within 30 days/activation notice OR mail from government agency
- \_\*If you are enrolling a student in grades 1-5\*\*, we must receive a copy of your child's final report card from their previous school showing end of year promotion/retention status and withdrawal form.
- \*\* Your child must be five on or before September 1st to be eligible for kindergarten. If you have a first grader, under Florida law your child must be six on or before September 1st to enroll. We will need a copy of the kindergarten report card or letter from his or her previous school showing that your child has successfully completed kindergarten.
