FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: I do not see World History on the Course Request Form. When will I take that?

A: Students need three Social Studies credits to graduate. At Leon, you will take World History in 10th grade, US History in 11th grade, and Government and Economics in 12th grade.

Q: How do I select the appropriate math, science, and English courses?

A: Talk to your middle school teachers. They have worked with you all year and will be able to guide you.
