The Blueprint Intergovernmental Agency is tasked with implementing various infrastructure projects on the Southside, including:

1. expansion of storm-water infrastructure along the central drainage ditch
2. the Airport Gateway project

These projects result in **the seizure of private property and the displacement of residents. They raise issues of race; economic status; the environment, trees, and water management safety; housing; and equity. Is this fair? Is this right?**
