Congratulations to all of our Elizabeth Cobb Middle School 8th Graders! We are extremely proud of your accomplishments, and we know that your future is bright. We are proud to announce our Second Annual 8th Grade Drive-Through Promotion Parade. It is important that we observe all of the CDC recommendations regarding COVID-19. To that end, please review and acknowledge the following guidelines in order to participate in your 8th Grade Drive-Through Ceremony Parade:

- Each 8th grader who has met the following requirements will be able to participate in the CMS 8th Grade Drive-Through Promotion Parade:
 - 1. Four (4) quality points earned in each core course
 - 2. Submitted proof of address for high school
 - 3. Returned or paid for all media center materials
- Each 8th grader will be allowed to participate in the parade in one car or truck. A parade route map will be published. We encourage family members and friends to park along the route to cheer on our 8th graders.
- Each 8th grader may have the number of family members in his/her car that equals the number of factory-installed seat belts within the vehicle.
- 8th graders (and guests), using one car, should arrive at Winthrop Park between 5:00 and 5:30 PM to line up. Please allow for traffic as the parade will begin at 5:45. A map will be provided.
- Participating 8th graders will be pre-screened/vetted before entering the parade line at the Winthrop Parking lot. This process will ensure that each 8th grader has a signed participation acknowledgement form on file. Once this is confirmed, the car will be marked with the 8th Grader's identification. This identification will be used to announce the 8th Grader's name at the CMS bus loop before receiving their medal and certificates in accordance with all COVID-19 requirements.
- 8th graders will be allowed to decorate his/her car within reason, and following all state and local laws of motor safety compliance.
