Common Sense Parenting offers training for parents who want to build on their existing skills or learn new ways of dealing with their children's behaviors. Professional parent trainers teach the course.

## CSP classes can help you:

- » Build strong, healthy relationships with your children
- » Correct and change a child's problem behavior
- » Minimize problems that disrupt family life
- » Raise responsible, caring children

## You'll learn valuable skills, including how to:

- » Communicate effectively
- » Avoid power struggles

#### Sessions include...

- » How I Grow and Learn helps you understand child development, set expectations based on your child's development and find different ways to nurture your child.

- » **Correcting Problem Behavior** responds to children's problem behavior with teaching and practicing acceptable alternatives. You will make a staying calm plan for when you get upset with your children.
