#### **How It Works**

- Schedule a screening through our website at whoweplayfor.org

  - WWPF and Leon County schools perform screenings.
- ECGs are interpreted by pediatric 3 cardiologists proficient in the interpretation of ECGs in children.
- Results are delivered to students's parent or quardian, 4 and are connected with appropriate follow-up care.
