## Reminders & Announcements

### Penny Wars:

Its that time of year again: Penny Wars Penny wars will begin Monday February 13th and run through Monday February 27th . 100% of the proceeds from this will go to Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. The way Penny Wars works: Week 1 (February 13th - 17th) Students bring in as many pennies as they can to their homeroom teacher. Each penny is worth 5 points. You are trying to get as many points as possible from pennies before ""bombing" week begins because you cant bring pennies in during bombing week. Bombing week begins Tuesday February 21st and goes to Monday February 27th . Students can "bomb" penny jars with dollar bills and silver coins. This subtracts from your penny points total. For example if a student puts a \$5 bill in your jar it subtracts 500 points from your jar, if they put a dime it subtracts 10 points. The goal is to still have the most points from pennies after bombing week. The winning homeroom with the most points from pennies will win a breakfast buffet. Its a friendly competition for a good cause!

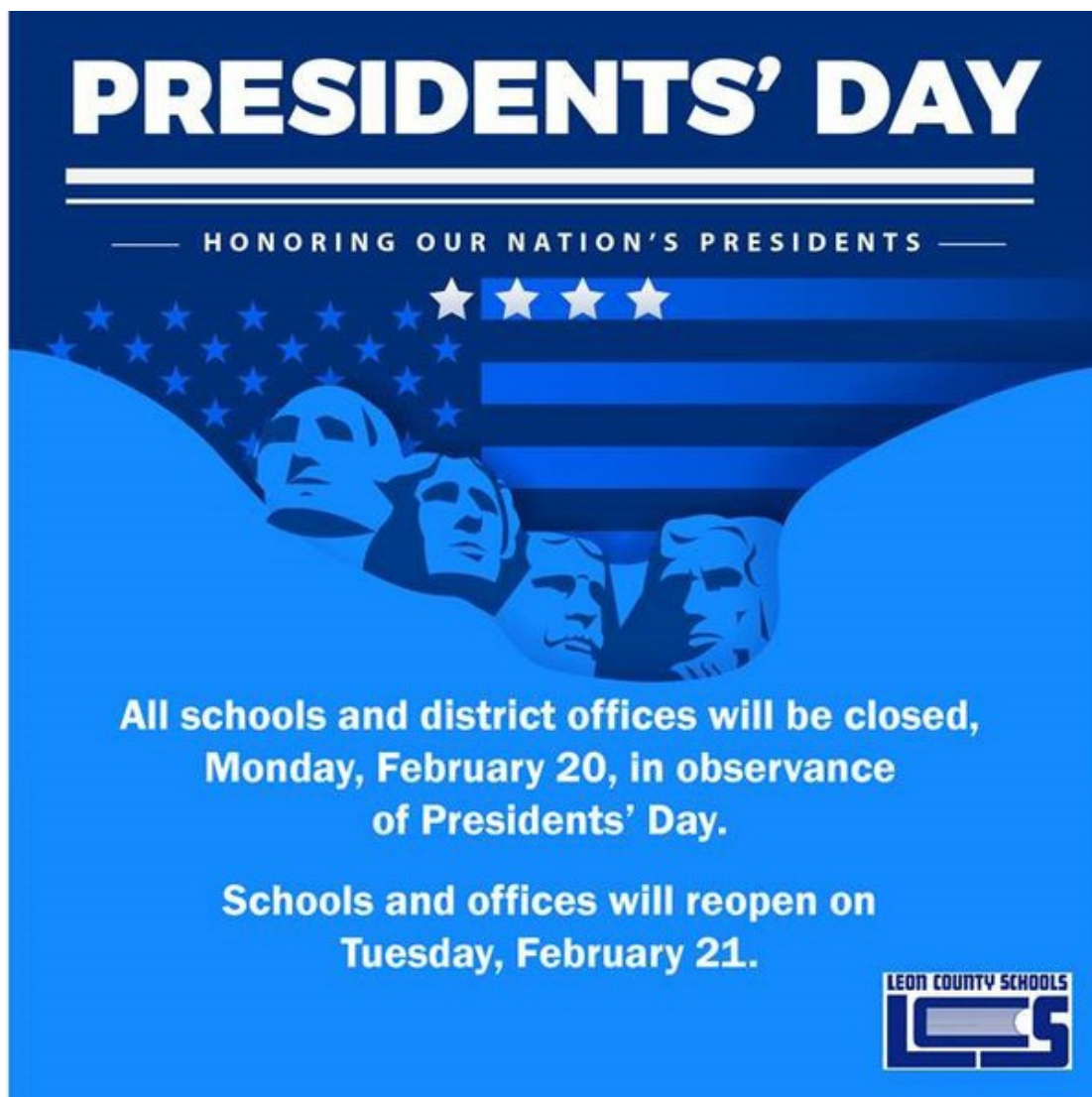
