## Reminders & Announcements

### 8th Grade Address Verification

8th Grade students and parents in order to be placed at your correct high school, 2 current proofs of address are required. The proofs that are accepted are listed below, all proofs of address must be submitted in order for students to participate in the end of the year activities (8th grade dance, Flying Up, Field trips, etc). Address verification documents are submitted to Ms. Dorsey ([dorsey@leonschools.net](mailto:dorsey@leonschools.net)) and should include students full legal name and grade level if emailed.

Acceptable Proofs of Address (Two proofs of residency):

- Homestead exemption, mortgage deed, lease, rental agreement, or property tax record -AND-
- Current utility bill, (dated within 30 days) activation notice is acceptable, Vehicle registration, Government mail (excluding a voter's registration card or Driver's license)

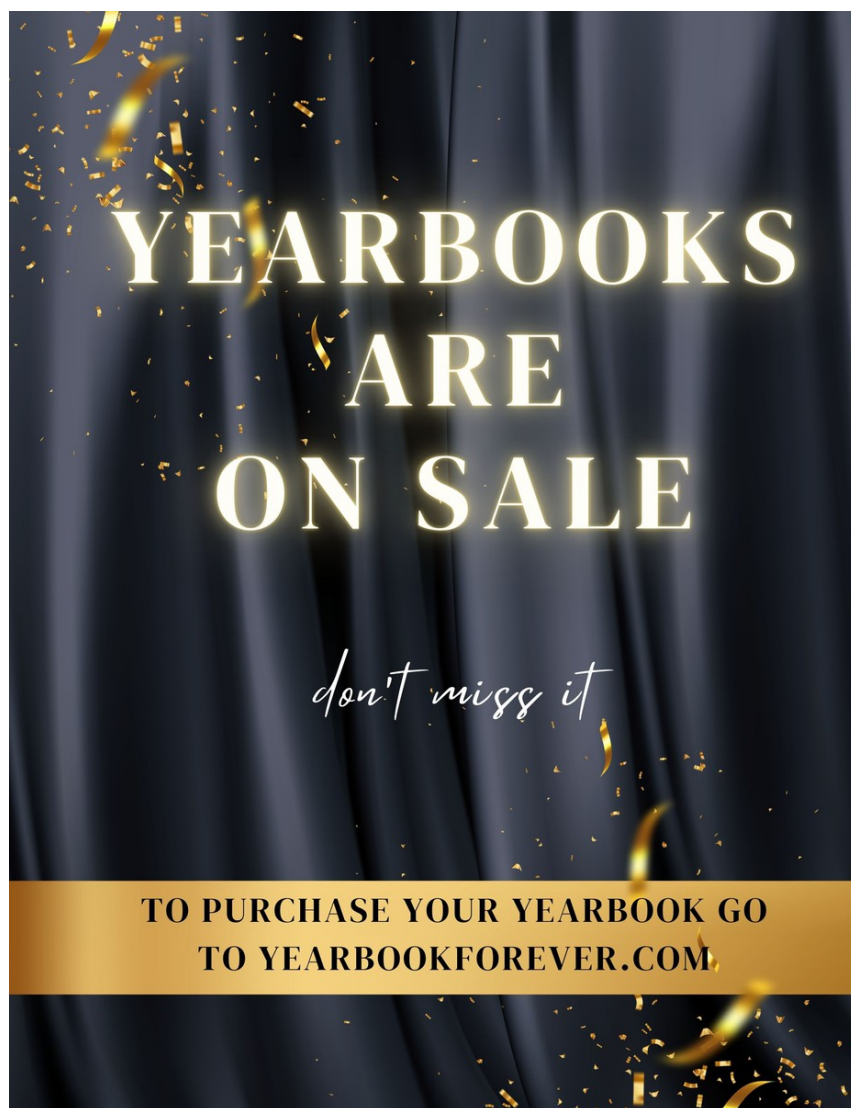
### Girls Softball

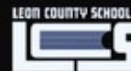

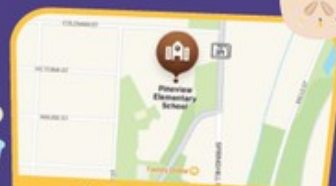

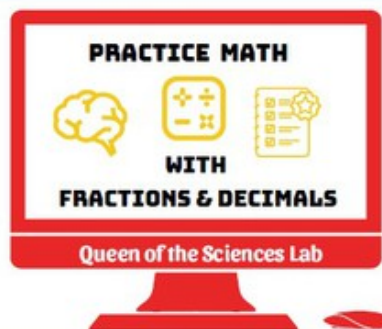
