- · Homestead exemption, mortgage deed, lease, rental agreement, or property tax record -AND-
- Current utility bill, (dated within 30 days) activation notice is acceptable, Vehicle registration, Government mail (<u>excluding</u> a voter's registration card or Driver's license)


### 8th Grade News


#### **Girls Softball**




