

Citizens for a Sustainable Future Climate Justice Scholarship

Application Deadline: May 1, 2023

Scholarship Award: \$500.00

Eligibility Requirements:

1.The applicant must be an African American senior in their last semester at a local Leon or Gadsden County high school.

- 2.The applicant must have earned an overall unweighted grade point average of at least a 2.7 or above on a 4.0 scale -- unweighted.
- 3. The applicant must have applied or been accepted to a post-secondary institution: university, four-year college, or community college for the 2023-2024 academic year.
- 4. The applicants major of study must be relevant to climate and environmental justice.

Scholarship Terms: An initial award letter will be sent to the recipients at the close of the application review period.

Candidate Interview Process: All finalist must complete a virtual or in-person interview.

Award Date: Awarded at the end of the 2022-2023 school year.

Payment of scholarship: The scholarship check will be presented to the recipient(s) upon proof of enrollment (class schedule) in an institution of higher learning, on a date indicted by the committee.

Application Checklist: All items must be submitted no later than May 1, 2023. The application must include each item listed in the checklist below:

- An uploaded copy of the application's unofficial high school transcript; including first-semester senior year grades. Please blackout sensitive information, such as social security numbers prior to submission.
- An uploaded copy of your College Acceptance Letter
- An uploaded copy of current photograph
- A typed essay (300-500 words) answering the question below. All essays will be judged on content, organization, grammar, and spelling.
- Please explain how you will use your college education to advance climate justice in vulnerable communities?
