Reminders & Announcements

8th Grade Address Verification

Leon County Schools Policy 5112 requires verification of current residence of 5th grade and 8th grade students transitioning to middle school or high school. We will need primary and secondary proof of address for (a list of acceptable documents is provided below). As of today, these documents have not been received for your student. Your child will not receive a schedule at their new school without these proofs being provided. Two proofs of address are due to the LCS Office of Admissions by, <u>Monday, May 1, 2023</u>

Policy 5112 v. STUDENT PROMOTION TO NEXT LEVEL When students are promoted to the next level, from elementary school to middle school or from middle school to high school, the

parent/legal guardian must provide current proof of residence in order to obtain a schedule prior to promoting to the next level.

Acceptable Proofs of Address (Two proofs of residency one **MUST** be from each category below):

<u>Category #1</u> Homestead exemption, mortgage deed, lease, rental agreement, or property tax record

-AND-

<u>Category #2</u> Current utility bill, (dated within 30 days) activation notice is acceptable, Vehicle registration, Government mail (excluding a voter's registration card or Driver's license)

These two proofs can be uploaded to LCS admissions, by emailing them to <u>lcsadmissions@leonschools.net</u> OR bring the copies to the school to Ms. Dorsey. Please only choose one method of sending the documents.

<u>Students who do not submit verification, will not be eligible to participate in the end of the year</u> <u>activities including the end of the year field trip, the 8th grade dance or the Flying Up Celebration.</u> If you have questions, please contact Ms. Dorsey at (850)488-6880 or <u>DorseyM@leonschools.net</u>

Rickards Cheer:



We will pay \$20/hour, and we may be able to arrange transportation if needed.


