The five classes required for the FCCPC are:

- *EEC1308 – Education of the Young Child
- *EEC1907 – Directed Observation and Participation
- *EDF1004 – Educational Field Experience
- EEC1603 – Early Childhood Development and Guidance
- EEC2401 – Home, School and Community in Early Childhood Education

*The courses marked with an asterisk are not required if you have an A.S. or A.A. Degree or higher, or if you have a current and recognized CDA/FCCPC. You will be given 9 hours of college credit in these cases.
