Dear Senior and Parent(s),

In an effort to provide you support in passing the required grade 10 FSA ELA state assessment to earn your high school diploma, via a concordant score on the SAT or ACT test, we are offering **Free SAT or ACT Test Prep Bootcamps** specifically for Leon County Schools high school seniors (and Juniors for July ACT) who still need to pass the ELA state assessment for graduation. Mr. Ken Bishop, Florida Certified Leon County Schools teacher, will be providing instruction. Mr. Bishop can be reached at 850-296-9382 or [bishopk@leonschools.net](mailto:bishopk@leonschools.net). All materials will be provided. Please bring a pencil; a wristwatch or stopwatch that cannot transmit information is recommended (i.e. no smart watches, etc..).

Bootcamp prep sessions will be held thorough out the summer starting May 25 – July 13<sup>th</sup> in preparation for the June 3<sup>rd</sup> Sat, June 10<sup>th</sup> ACT, or July 15<sup>th</sup> ACT. You need to have your own transportation. StarMetro provides 24/7 free city bus service for all Leon County students with a StarCard, apply for a StarCard in FOCUS Parent Portal.

It is required that you are registered for the test prior to the start of the bootcamp. Late registration is still available for the June 3<sup>rd</sup> SAT at [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com) (until May 23<sup>rd</sup> – late fees apply); late registration for the June 10<sup>th</sup> ACT at [www.act.org](http://www.act.org) (until May 19<sup>th</sup>) OR regular registration is currently open for July 15<sup>th</sup> ACT. There is a fee to register for the test; fee waiver eligibility information is also online at <https://www.act.org/content/act/en/products-and-services/the-act/registration/fees/fee-waivers.html> for ACT and at <https://satsuite.collegeboard.org/sat/registration/fee-waivers/fee-waiver-eligibility> for the SAT- **contact your home zone high school Guidance office for assistance.**

**Important note: it is required to attend the first session and equally important to attend all sessions to get the most preparation/practice.** Space is limited to 50 students, please register to attend at least 48 hours prior to the first session date.
