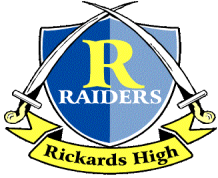

3. Please bring this form on the day of your visit.
4. **Bring a copy of your most recent report card showing your middle school GPA and the courses you are currently taking.**
5. Check in at the JSRHS front desk at 7:20 a.m., where Mrs. Williams or an IB student will be waiting to greet you. Classes begin at 7:30 a.m. Promptness is very important.
6. The school day ends at 1:50 p.m. Please make arrangements for transportation accordingly.
7. Most IB students bring their own lunch, but you do have the option of eating in the school cafeteria for free.

Shadowing Instructions

Students wishing to shadow in the IB program at Rickards High School find their experience very rewarding and integral to their decision to attend our program. Shadowing occurs in the months of January and February (and March for students who are zoned for Rickards High School) on specified dates. Prior to shadowing, each student and their parent must:

1. Obtain an appointment date to shadow, in advance, by contacting the IB Academic Dean, Mrs. Victoria Williams, at williamsv3@leonschools.net or at 850-414-5597.
2. Complete the Permission to Shadow Form and obtain the required approval signature from an administrator at your current school.
3. Bring the form with the student on their shadowing date to the Rickards front office and give it to Mrs. Williams.
4. Bring a copy of the most recent report card showing the student's middle school GPA and current class schedule.
